**Amateur Rider (AR) & Open categories in each test Preparatory up to and including Advanced for closed restricted (CR) events and Amateur Owner Rider (AOR) & Open categories in each test Preparatory up to and including Advanced for official competitive (OC) events.**

There must be a minimum of 8 horses entered in each category for the split to occur.

**Ponies will be split into their own category in all OC tests.**

**See website for [NCEC AR eligibility](#) – rider is responsible for choosing the correct category on Nominate, this cannot be changed once entry is submitted and paid for**

**Riders can ride maximum of 3 horses at the competition**

It is a NCEC requirement of entry that riders undertake a short duty for the event (Set-up, Gear check steward, Warm-up arena steward or Pack-up). We may use the program Sign-up for you to be able to choose the most convenient time for your duty. Any competitor that does not sign up, within 24 hours of release of the draw, will be allocated a duty at the discretion of the committee

**Championships Rules**

- Competitors must compete in both tests at level to be eligible for champion points
- Championships are decided on points with all horses ranked in each of the two tests.
  - First placed horses will get 35 points,
  - second will get 34 points,
  - third will get 33 points and so on to the last placed horse
- the Champion is the horse with the highest combined points of the two tests
  - in the event of a tie,
    - the Champion will be the horse with the highest aggregate percentage at that level
    - in the event of a further tie, the horse with the highest percentage in the higher competition at that level will be deemed the Champion

### **GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY (Please read carefully)**

Events will be held in accordance with current EA Dressage Rules except where FEI Rules apply. **The onus is on competitors to know the rules.**

**NCEC Amateur Rider (AR) Rules.** Please see [website](#) for further information

**Note:** NCEC AR rules differ from National AOR rules.

### **Other Conditions & Rules**

- **Only horses that are entered in the NCEC event are permitted on or around the competition grounds during the event, including the warm up arena.**
- **Bridle Numbers:** all horses entered at this event MUST have a bridle number. [Please visit our website on how to obtain one.](#)
- **Judges:** Due to judge availability NCEC may use only one judge per class.
- **Scratching** before close of entries - the entry fee will be refunded minus the admin fee.
- **Refunds:** After the close of entries the club will refund 50% of entry fees plus the horse levy when presented with a Veterinary or Doctors certificate within 48 hours of the competition. The compulsory Admin fee is not refundable under any circumstances – including event cancellations.
- **DNAs** please show the courtesy of scratching before the day if you are unable to attend the event.
- **Height of horses and ponies:** Refer to current EA Dressage Rules. Pony entrants will need to produce a height certificate if requested by the NCEC committee.
- **Stallions:** Effective as of 01 January 2011, the horse (stallion) & Float must display Stallion Identification Discs at all times. Discs are available for purchase from the National Office of Equestrian Australia. Stallions are to be handled as per EA guidelines.
- **Riders** may be changed before the start of competition – notification must be in writing at least 40 minutes prior to the start of that competition. The rider cannot be changed if another rider has already ridden the horse on the day, either in warm-up or in a competition.
- **Draw positions** cannot be changed without the permission of the Organising Committee. A competitor may not add/replace a horse to/in the draw without approval of the Organising Committee
- **Conditions for Riding Attire & Hats.** As per EA Rules or special conditions as covered in the Competition schedule. Riders must wear an approved safety helmet at all times when on a horse.
- **Gear Check** – all competitors must present to the Gear Steward PRIOR TO THEIR TEST - failure to do so may incur elimination.
- **Warm-up** - please use the designated sand warm-up arena. Be aware of group riding rules, look where you are going and keep at least 10m from competition arenas.
- **Lunging** is only allowed in the designated area in the Cotter plots and not on the competition or warm up arenas.
- No dogs are allowed anywhere near the warmup or competition arenas. Dogs must be on a leash at all times.
- **Callers** are allowed in all tests, except FEI.
- **Random swabbing** may take place. If approached by the Official Steward /Vet Officer of the day, competitors must allow samples to be taken from their horse for drug tests.
- **Welfare of the horse is paramount** - Refer to current EA Dressage competition rules.
- **Late Entries** – No late entries will be accepted. Please do not contact NCEC Committee members to request a late entry as the request will be refused.
