- The Equestrian Park Competition area will open at **7:30am** on Sunday 2 December 2018.
- Only 3 arenas will be in use 3, 4 & 5 {SEE MAP ON PAGE 2}.
- **Scratchings** – If you are unable to attend prior to or on the day, please **TEXT** your name, your horses name and the test you are scratching from to **Dianne Andison: 0438 892 910**
- Refunds (50% of the entry fees only & not including the admin fee) will be provided on the presentation of a medical/veterinarian certificate within 48 hours of the competition to ncecevents@gmail.com
- **The yards near the arenas will be RESERVED for Judges and Committee only.**
- **ONLY HORSES THAT ARE COMPETING ARE ALLOWED IN THE WARM-UP ARENAS.**
- **NO dogs allowed** in the competition area and elsewhere all dogs **must** be on leads at all times.

- Classes are run in accordance with the **2018 EA rules**; please make sure that your equipment will pass the gear check & that you are aware of the rules.
- You must attend the gear check prior to presenting to your Judge.
- Callers are **permitted** in all tests.
- Test sheets for any class will not be available until that class is complete and the scores are signed by the judge. Tests and prizes will be available for collection from the Cottage (marked on the map on the next page). There will be presentations for Champions & Reserve at lunchtime and the end of the day, these will be down near the arenas.
- Please leave \$1 and your full name and address at the cottage if you wish to have your test sheets posted to you. Please note that ribbons and prizes will not be posted and these **MUST** be collected on the day.
- Please observe the rules of the **Warm-Up arena** – there will be signs posted at the gate.
- The EP Park Manager requests that **all riders and attendees** please ensure that the front gates of Equestrian Park are closed once you have moved through them. This is to ensure that horses are not able to get out onto Cotter Road, where accidents can happen.
- **Please make sure you put all of your rubbish in the bin or bring a rubbish bag with you!**
