- The Equestrian Park Competition area will open at **7:00am** on Sunday 21 March 2021.
- **Please ensure that you have read and understood the NCEC COVID-19 Plan (attached).**
- All 5 arenas will be in use {SEE MAP ON PAGE 2}. Please note that Arena 1 and 2 are now on the 2nd pad not the first as per previous competitions.
- **Scratchings** – If you are unable to attend prior to or on the day, please **TEXT** your name, your horses name, and the test you are scratching from to **Jacqui Knobel 0457 747 057**
- Refunds (50% of the entry fees only & not including the admin fee) will be provided on the presentation of a medical/veterinarian certificate within 48 hours of the event to ncecevents@gmail.com
- **The yards near the arenas will be RESERVED for Judges and Committee only.**
- **Please make sure that if parking in the area of the competition all floats need to be parked left of the main gate.**
- **ONLY HORSES THAT ARE ENTERED IN THIS EVENT ARE ALLOWED IN THE WARM-UP ARENAS.**
- **NO dogs allowed** in the competition area and elsewhere all dogs **must** be on leads at all times.
- **Coffee N Snack Shack will be in attendance for all your coffee and food needs! Please support the caterer, it is wonderful to have them on the grounds so pop over, say hi and grab a great coffee and snack ☺. Menus are attached.**
- Classes are run in accordance with the **current EA rules**; please make sure that your equipment will pass the gear check & that you are aware of the rules.
- **Gear check will commence at 8:15am.** You must attend the gear check prior to presenting to your Judge.
- Callers are **permitted** in all tests except FEI tests.
- Interim results will be available on the day under current events at : <https://www.nominate.com.au/Scoreboard/results/> or through using the app. The app is called Nominate Scoreboard and can be downloaded from Google Play or the Apple app store. It works on phones and tablets. Users get the option to sign in as a competitor, or as a visitor. It is important that you allow notifications so that you get messages sent by the event organisers as well as your results.
- Ribbons to 6th place and prizes to 3rd place will be available from the Cottage once the results are finalised and signed off by the judges.
- Please observe the rules of the **Warm-Up arena** – there will be signs posted at the entry gate.
- The Equestrian Park Manager requests that **all riders and attendees** please ensure that the front gates of Equestrian Park are closed once you have moved through them. This is to ensure that horses are not able to get out onto Cotter Road, where accidents can happen.
- For Official classes, ponies will be separated as their own category. In all other classes ponies are included in the general scoring.
- **Please make sure you put all of your rubbish in the bin or bring a rubbish bag with you!**
